COACH SELECTION



Purpose:

To ensure a fair, transparent, and structured process for selecting volunteer coaches for minor hockey teams.

Coach Selection Committee:

The committee shall consist of 5 members:

- 1. President
- 2. (2) Vice Presidents
- 3. Coach Coordinator
- 4. One member at large, appointed by the executive.

Coach Selection Process:

- Application Call-Out: Announce coaching opportunities to all association members (email, social media, website)
- Application Submission: Interested coaches fill out and submit the application form found on the Renegades website to the coach Coordinator.
- 3. Application Review: Committee reviews applications, considering the following with no specific rating given to each category:
 - -Coaching experience
 - -Certification qualifications
 - -Team needs and requirements
 - -Previous coach feedback forms
- 4. Interviews (Optional):
 - Committee may conduct interviews if necessary (e.g., new coaches or multiple applicants for a single team)
- 5. Selection: Committee selects coaches for each team, considering:
 - Best fit for the team's needs

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- Coaching style and philosophy
- Player development goals
- 6. Ratification:

The Board of Directors ratifies the committee's selections

7. Notification:

Successful candidates are notified and announced to the association.

Additional Considerations:

- Team assistant coach selections each coach will select up to 3 Assistant coaches with the board's approval.
- -Conflict of Interest:
- Committee members with a conflict of interest (e.g., an immediate family member applying for a coaching position) shall recuse themselves from the selection process.
